



Important Queen's Jubilee Celebrations at Britannia

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you will know the Queen's Jubilee celebrations are almost upon us and I am writing to inform you about our plans to celebrate this significant historical event in school.

On **Friday 27th May** the children may come to school dressed in red, white and blue. Your child will take part in an assembly which will start at 9.15am in the hall and they will be taking us through each decade of the Queen's reign with each class taking on a decade to share with us. Parents are invited to this event and are welcome to watch the assembly. However, please remember that our hall is relatively small so we cannot accommodate everyone unfortunately. This assembly will be filmed for those people unable to attend and shared securely on School Spider.

Throughout the rest of the day, the children will be taking part in activities learning about the Queen and her fantastic achievements. They will also be creating their own portrait of the Queen which will go onto the whole school display board to mark this occasion. The children will have their lunch as a picnic and will play games on the 'lawn' in the afternoon with the staff.

As part of this special day, we are trying to get the whole school community involved and are going to be having a 'design a crown competition' with a winner from each class receiving a special prize. We are asking you at home with your child to design and make a special crown for the Queen's Jubilee. You should carefully consider the decoration so that it symbolises the significance of this historical event. It is unlikely that anyone will ever again see a monarch reign for such a period of time so this is an occasion that should be marked by us all. These crowns should be sent into school no later than the **27th May** and we will place them into the 'Tower of Britannia' for viewing on **Friday 27th May at 2.30pm**. It would be lovely if every child would have a go at this so please try and support your child with this task.

At 2.30pm, families are welcome to come and view the Crown Jewels in the school hall. Children may be collected from this time and brought into the hall to view them with you. The competition will be judged by members of the Governing Body and the winners will be revealed after the May holiday in Gold Book Assembly.
