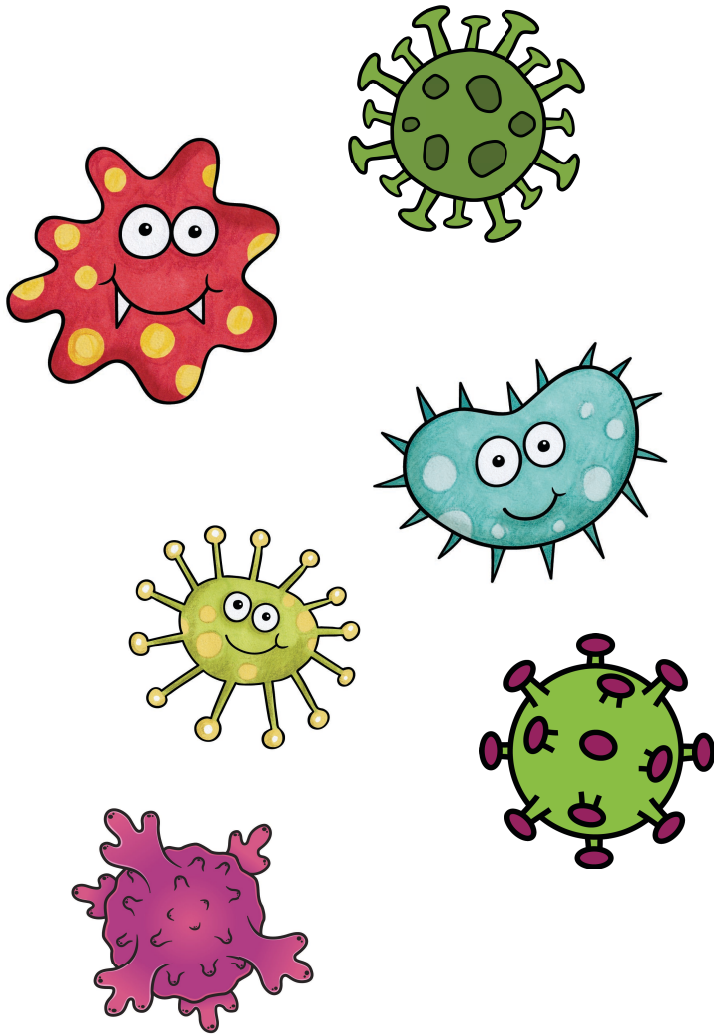


# Masks, Face Shields and GLOVES, Oh my!

protective equipment.



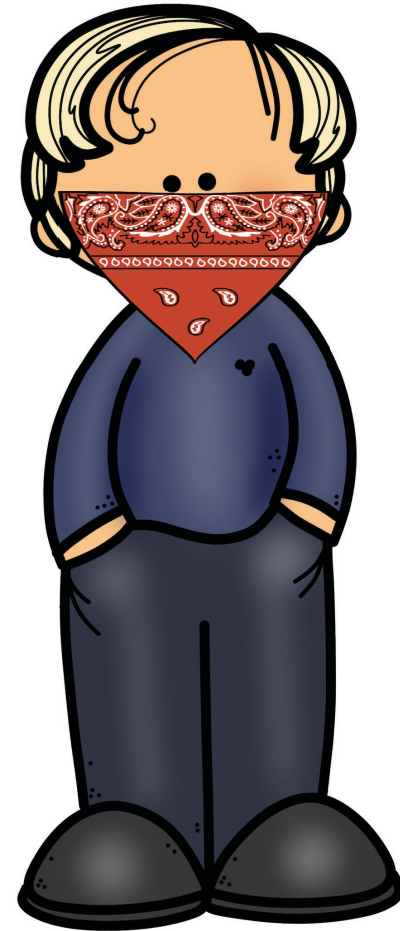
Protective equipment keeps people safe from germs.

Usually, a doctor, nurse or dentist will wear a face shield.

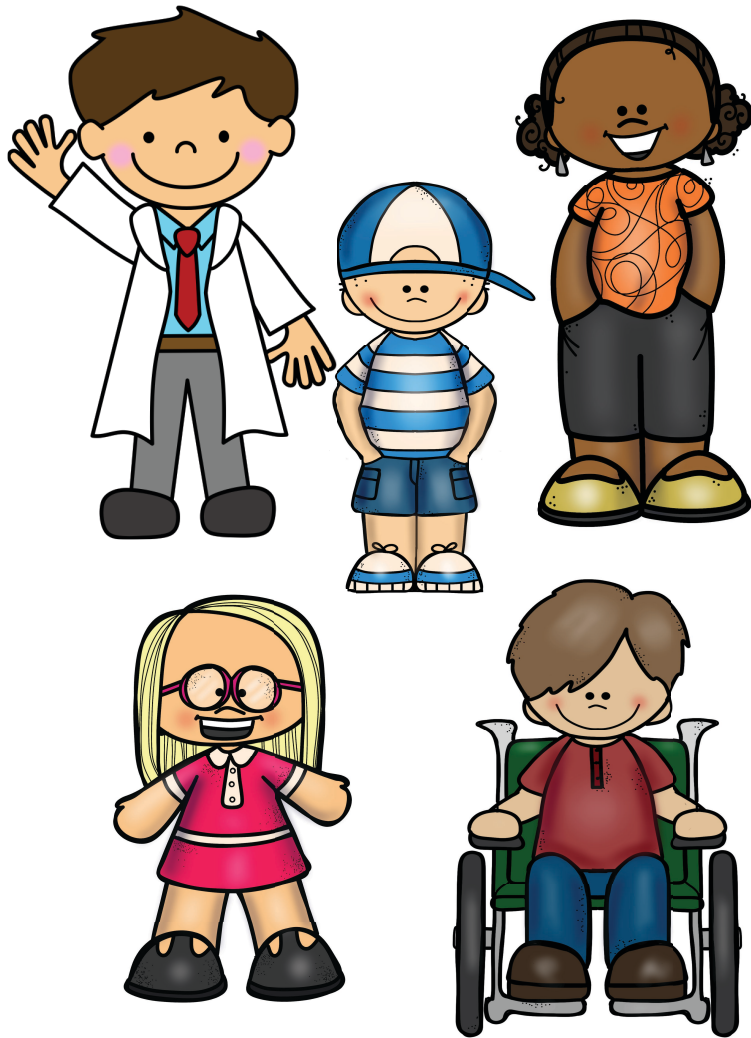




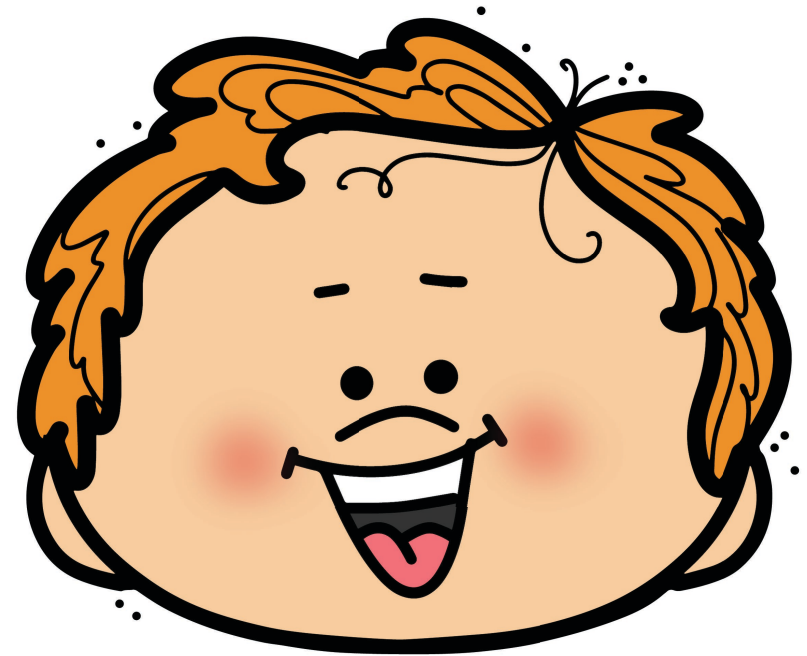
A face shield can protect from coughs and sneezes



Gloves can also protect people from germs.



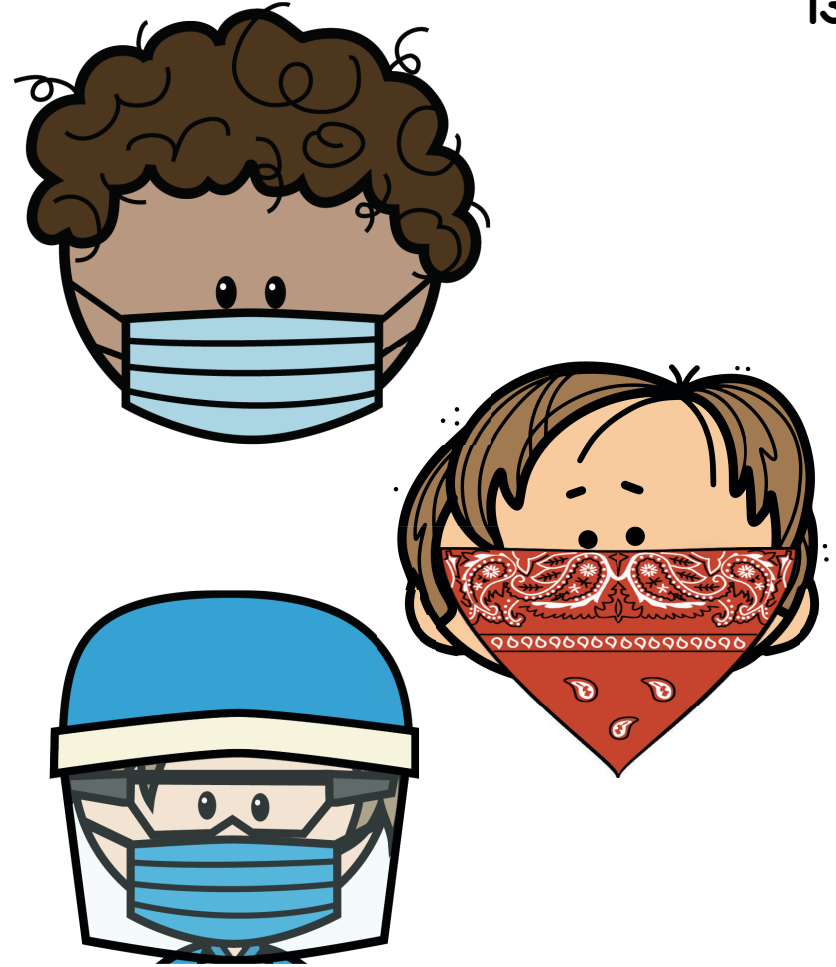
I can try to remember
