ART GALLERY

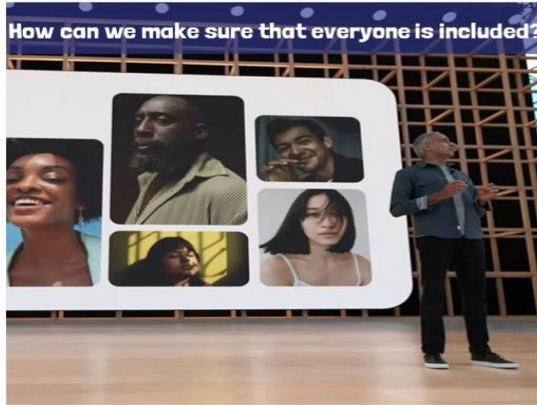
